Year 4 Multiplication Test

Although statutory testing for Year 4 pupils has been deferred for this year, as a school we have voluntarily opted for our children to participate. Therefore, all our Year 4 children will undertake the test during the second half of the summer term. Mr. Jellyman will be running two meetings for parents of children in Year 4 in the main school hall on Tuesday 25th May (for parents of children in 4H); and on Thursday 27th May (for parents of children in 4P). As explained in Mrs. Leavey's letter to parents of Year 4 children (which was sent out on Tuesday 11th May), the meeting will give you ideas that you can use to support and prepare your child with at home. I am resending that letter home again today with pupils whose parents have, so far not indicated whether or not that they wish to attend the meeting.

Mathletics

Mathletics is an online resource that children can access at home (as well as at school) which supports their mathematical development. It is very popular with our children as the following range of comments from year groups school indicate:

Year 1

'It's fun'

'It really let's you understand maths

'You need to learn or your brain will stop working'

Year 3

'It helps you get smarter at maths

'There are a lot of activities that are really fun and they help you learn'

'I like mathletics because sometimes it's adding and sometimes it's multiplication, and I can answer calculations. It makes me like maths.

Year 5

'It includes games and it makes learning fun'

'It helps you with your learning and it reminds you of things you did in previous year groups and will help me for when I'm in Year 6.

'It teaches you a lot'
