Welcome Back and Happy New Year

I would like to begin the first newsletter of 2022 by wishing all of our school community a very happy and prosperous new year.

Covid-19 Guidance

I am sure that many of you will have reservations regarding the Omicron variation of Covid-19 following reports in the press that infections have risen to unprecedented levels in recent weeks. Please be assured that school will always put the health and safety of your children first and foremost and we will always act and take decisions in their best interests.

To this end, we will continue to be guided by the Department for Education (DfE) and the United Kingdom Health Security Agency (UKHSA) in order to manage the risk of spreading the virus while at the same time reducing the disruption to children's education.

Attendance for all pupils is mandatory even in the event of your child being identified as a close contact of someone who has developed Covid-19. Unless the child themselves has shown symptoms of Covid-19 they should continue to attend school.

In line with DfE guidance we will not be returning to 'bubbles' in school at this time.

To keep staff, your children and indeed yourselves safe, I respectfully ask parents and carers to pick up your child from school at their allotted finishing time and to not congregate in groups at school gates or in the outside shelters. Please also ensure that you leave the premises as soon as you have collected your child(ren). If you have more than one child in school and there is a gap between them being collected, please keep the child that you have picked up first with you by your side and do not let them roam or play with the school equipment. Adhering to these simple requests supports the minimising of spreading the virus.

I am delighted to introduce three new colleagues to our staff team.

Miss Laila will be supporting the teaching in EYFS, Mrs. Chapman will be supporting the teaching in Year 2 and Mr Arnold will be teaching Mrs. Taylor's former class 4T (please note that for convenience, this class will continue to be known as 4T).

In addition to these newly appointed staff, I am happy to announce that Mrs. Davies will continue to be part of the Marsh Hill team after initially working with us as a Teaching Assistant in Year 3 during the autumn term.
