Tests Results

- The tests will be externally marked (on screen) by trained markers.
- The raw score on the test (the marks achieved out of the total marks available) will be converted into a <u>scaled</u> <u>score</u>.
- Each pupil will receive an overall result indicating whether or not he or she has achieved the required standard/pass mark on the test.
- In order for your child to achieve the required standard, their scaled score has to be 100 or more.
- If your child gains less than 100, they will not have achieved the expected standard.
