Google Classroom - Thursday 4th July 2024

As you will be aware, on Thursday 4th July we will be closed to all pupils and staff due to the school being used as a Polling Station for the General Election. As part of our commitment to your child's education, we will be providing work for the children to complete during the school closure. We are using Google Classroom to provide online learning for this day.

Each class will be having a google meet live registration in the morning to explain the work for the morning and another google meet live registration in the afternoon to explain the afternoon work. Pupils should be dressed appropriately for the meets and parents should not be on the screen. A google meet is an online meeting where the teacher and pupils will meet as a class to talk through the learning activities for the day. Your child has been shown how to get into the Google classrooms meeting by their teacher.

In order to join the video call successfully, please ensure that your child has access to a device with a camera and a microphone.
